H. pylori Urea Breath Test (UBT)

Preparation and Instruction for Investigation:

- 1. Patient should be fasted for at least 6 hours.
- 2. Avoid eating, drinking (including no water), taking any medication, smoking or physical exercise prior to the test.
- 3. Do not take any of the following medication for 2 weeks prior to the test.
 - a. Bismuth preparation (Pepto Bismol)
 - b. Proton pump inhibitors (e.g.: Losec, Prevacid, Pantoloc, Nexium, Pariet)
- 4. Do not test before 4 weeks after Helicobactor eradication therapy (on antibiotics).
- 5. The test should not be performed in patients with gastrectomy.
- 6. In case it is necessary to repeat the test, this should be done after 24 hours.

Procedures:

- 1. Patient should sit quietly for 5 minutes.
- 2. Collect baseline sample bag:



- a. Breathe normally, then hold the breath for 5 10 seconds.
- b. Exhale into the mouthpiece of bag.
- c. Cap or clip firmly the mouthpiece of bag.
- d. Fill in patient information on green BASE sample label.



- 3. Instruct patient to swallow the whole tablet. If the patient chews the tablet, the test must be performed again after 24 hours of a false positive result increase.
- 4. Have the patient sit quietly for **10 minutes**.
- 5. If the patient cannot swallow the tablet, dissolve the tablet in water. Post dose breath sample will be collected after 30 minutes.
- 6. Collect Post dose sample bag:
 - e. Breathe normally, then hold the breath for 5 10 seconds.
 - f. Exhale into the mouthpiece of bag.
 - g. Cap or clip firmly the mouthpiece of bag.
 - h. Fill in patient information on red POST sample label.



7. Check sample bags are capped properly and keep at room temperature.

Note: If sample bag is not adequately filled by one breath, repeat the collection steps.

<u>Additional information:</u> Helicobacter Pylori Breath Test is not recommended for patient less than 6 years old. An alternate test (H.pylori Stool Antigen) is available for all patients.
